Baron de Baussac Viognier Languedoc-Roussillon, France (12.5%) A richly-textured white, with bright aromas of ripe apricot and peach, hints of grapefruit and fresh pineapple.	250ml	£38.00 £13.00
Come Pulpo y Bebe Vino Albariño Vin de Mesa, Spain (11.0%) The wine is very fresh and presents aromas of apple, lime or lemon. Very fresh on the palate, easy drinking.	250ml	£31.00 £10.70

Ghost in the Machine Chenin Blanc Swartland, South Africa (12.5%) Hints of aromatic bay leaf and cardamom with a smokey, nutty character picked up on the nose. On the palate this wine is creamy, juice on entry with a subtle lime lingering finish.		£46.00
Kokako Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand (13.0%) Gooseberry, pink grapefruit and tropical passionfruit with a citrus backbone. Fresh acidity with more mid-palate weight.	250ml	£36.00 £12.40

Beronia Rioja Tempranillo Joven Rioja, Spain (14.0%) Aromas of cherry with hints of spice including white pepper and notes of tobacco. On the palate, the wine is fresh and very fruit forward, balanced with notes of cinnamon and spice.	250ml	£38.00 £13.00
Five Ravens Pinot Noir Romania (13.0%) Romania may not be the first place you think of when you are looking to buy a Pinot Noir but this has all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy note you would expect.	250ml	£28.00 £9.70
Ghost in the Machine Malbec-Viognier Western Cape, South Africa (13.5%) Herbaceous with hints of fynbos, rosemary and tobacco leaf, spiced or marinated red meats with a biltong coating. The palate bursts with plum and cherries - smokey.		£46.00
Hillville Road Shiraz South East Australia (13.5%) Very good fruit intensity of raspberries and black cherries with well-integrated vanilla oak. This wine has soft round tannins and a good length.	250ml	£27.00 £9.40
Mozzafiato Primitivo Puglia IGT, Italy (13.0%) Mouth-coating palate of dried prune, date and cherry, with notes of sweet spice and a lick of chocolate. Great structure from the good balance between the soft tannins and acidity.	250ml	£36.00 £12.40
Pavillon des Trois Arches Merlot Languedoc-Roussillon, France (13.0%) Richly flavoured, packed full of plump plum and cedar notes. Ripe and generous tannins tie this wine together.	250ml	£33.00 £11.40
Quid Pro Quo Malbec Mendoza, Argentina (14.0%) Elegantly structured, rich, showing plummy fruit and hints of smoke and chocolate.		£42.00
